1 About the Club

Berkhamsted Raiders Community Football Club is a registered charity and an FA Charter Community Standard Club. The aims of the Charity are:

- To promote community participation in healthy recreation by providing facilities for playing football.
- To advance the education of children and young people whether or not undergoing formal education

Membership

In 2017/18, we will provide sport for a record number of members – over 1,000 boys and girls playing football in 80 teams from U7 to U18, plus a Ladies team, a Veterans team, Senior team, and initiatives for Walking Football and Inclusive Football. Our fastest growing section is Girls Football – our priority in terms of the club's development.

Management

The Club is run by volunteers – a Board of Trustees, and a Committee of eighteen people, plus fifteen Age Group Coordinators. Each of the teams has a Manager and Assistant Manager. All Managers are FA Level 1 qualified, have been through DBS checks and are First Aid trained.

Facilities

The Club does not have a home ground or club house. We play at many venues around the Berkhamsted area, creating football facilities for U7 & U8 (5v5); U9 & U10 (7v7); U11 & U12 (9v9) and 11v11 from U13 upwards, and funding pitches, goals and nets for the use of Raiders and our local schools.

BerkoAstro

In 2010, we succeeded in our bid for funding from the Football Foundation for BerkoAstro, a floodlit 3G pitch at Ashlyns School. The development cost £600,000 in total. An additional £150,000 was raised in 2012 to create the Paul Beard Centre alongside BerkoAstro. The Centre provides much needed facilities to support the use of the 3G pitch and is also used for FA training courses for players, coaches and referees.

2 Why sponsor Raiders?

It costs over £200,000 each year to provide participation in football for our 1,000 boys and girls. 3 Tournament sponsorship

In 2018, the Raiders Girls Tournament will take place on a Saturday or Sunday in June at Berkhamsted and Hemel Hempstead Hockey Club, Cow Roast.

The Tournament will be a major event in the Raiders calendar. We expect an entry of around 40 to 50 teams, attracting clubs from all over the area. The event is will attract around 1,000 players and parents.



The Tournament is an excellent opportunity to promote a business not only to the Berkhamsted community but also to the wider community in Hertfordshire.

Sponsorship benefits

- A dedicated sponsorship announcement in the Raiders email list via the enewsletter. The e-newsletter is distributed to a list of over 1,500 recipients which embraces Raiders families AND local "supporters" (Councillors, School Heads, community organisations, local businesses).
- Inclusion of the sponsor's name and logo as "Tournament Sponsor" on all Raiders e-newsletters.
- Inclusion of the sponsor's logo on all materials related to the tournament.
- Inclusion as a "Featured Sponsor" in one issue of the Raiders e-newsletter during the year.

The event could be football or multisport focused. Football participation could be facilitated for all ages and sexes through a "Walking Football" approach.
